

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What is the uniform policy?

UNIFORMS

Students of Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 8 are to be in complete uniform at all times, unless a special direction is given.

Pre-School 3 & 4 year olds:

Burgundy polo shirt (2-3 buttons) short or long sleeves with school crest

Khaki shorts, skorts or pants (No dresses or skirts)

Burgundy sweater (cardigan or pullover)

White socks

Tennis shoes (no wheels or lights) (No boots) plain black, white or maroon.

No jewelry or watches. Stud earrings only are to be worn by PK students.

Girls K – 5:

Skirt or skort (plaid #43) **Knee length** (Must be purchased online from Flynn & O’Hara or Parker Uniform)

Dark Khaki uniform shorts or pants (must be worn with black or brown belt)

White oxford blouse

Plaid (43) crisscross tie (Must be purchased online from Flynn & O’Hara Uniform)

Burgundy V-Neck sweater or sweater vest (November 1 – February 29) **not an optional item** (Must be purchased online from Flynn & O’Hara Uniform)

Socks/Tights: solid (no design) white, maroon or grey. Socks must be worn above the ankle

Tan Dirty Buck Shoes

Girls 6-8:

Skirt or skort (Plaid #43) (Must be purchased online from Flynn & O’Hara Uniform)

Dark Khaki uniform shorts or pants (must be worn with black or brown belt)

White oxford blouse

Plaid (43) crisscross tie (Must be purchased online from Flynn & O’Hara Uniform)

Burgundy V-Neck sweater or sweater vest (November 1 – February 29) **not an optional item** (Must be purchased online from Flynn & O’Hara or Parker Uniform)

Burgundy Blazer (November 1 – February 29) **not an optional item** (Must be purchased online from Flynn & O’Hara or Parker Uniform)

Blazer and sweater vest are to be worn together from November 1 – February 29!

Socks/Tights: solid (no design) white, maroon or grey. Socks must be worn above the ankle

Tan Dirty Buck Shoes

Boys K -5:

Dark Khaki shorts or pants (must be worn with black or brown belt)

White oxford shirt

Plaid tie (Plaid #43) (Must be purchased online from Flynn & O’Hara Uniform)

Burgundy V-Neck sweater or sweater vest (November 1 – February 29) **not an optional item**
(Must be purchased online from Flynn & O’Hara Uniform)

White or tan socks worn above the ankle

Tan Dirty Buck Shoes

Boys 6 – 8:

Dark Khaki shorts or pants (**must be worn with black or brown belt**)

White oxford shirt

Plaid tie (Plaid #43) (**Must be purchased online from Flynn & O’Hara Uniform**)

Burgundy V-Neck sweater or sweater vest (November 1 – February 29) **not an optional item**
(Must be purchased online from Flynn & O’Hara Uniform)

Burgundy Blazer **not an optional item** (**Must be purchased from Flynn & O’Hara Uniform**)

Blazer and sweater vest are to be worn together from November 1 – February 29!

White or tan socks worn above the ankle

Tan Dirty Buck Shoes

P.E. Uniforms Grades K – 8 Boys/Girls (**Must be purchased online from Flynn & O’Hara Uniform**)

Sports Grey t-shirt with school logo

Maroon mesh shorts with school logo

Maroon crew neck sweatshirt with school logo (**No other outer wear may replace sweatshirt**)

Sports Grey gathered leg sweatpants with school logo

White socks

Tennis shoes (no wheels or lights)

The school T-shirt **must always** be worn. Depending on the student’s choice, either the shorts or sweatpants may be worn as well as the school sweatshirt.

No other shorts, sweatpants or sweatshirt may be worn in place of the school PE uniform.

2. What are the cafeteria options?

- Pre-Kindergarten students are required by the State of Georgia to be served a lunch provided by the school.
- Kindergarten through 8th grade may buy lunch or bring it from home.
- Lunch payments are due the first of the month.
- Lunch is \$3.25 a day. Payments are sent in for the number of days a student will be eating that month.
- Applications for reduced and free lunch may be obtained at the school office.
- **No cans, bottles, or sodas may be brought from home.**
- St. Peter Claver Catholic School does offer a breakfast program.

3. What is the average class size?

Class sizes range from 15-25.

4. What types of extracurricular activities are there?

Students in grades 3-8 may be involved in basketball, archery, or soccer.

5. What type of discipline is employed?

The school discipline policy reflects the ideals of the gospel, and helps the individual student be responsible and accountable for his/her actions. Approved methods of correction include reminders, conferences with parents, withholding privileges, reparation for damages, discipline forms, suspension, or expulsion. Corporal punishment is never permitted.

6. Are scholarships/financial aid available?

Parents who desire financial aid must complete an application.

Families may apply through FACTSTUITIONAID.COM by March 1 to be considered for assistance. A decision will be reached after the interview is conducted.

7. Does the school offer transportation?

All transportation is the responsibility of the parent.

8. Do you have to be Catholic to attend?

St. Peter Claver Catholic School welcomes all students regardless of their religious beliefs. All students take Religion and participate in the spiritual life of the school.

9. What safety measures are taken by the school?

All staff members are trained in emergency procedures. All visitors must report to the office.

10. Does St. Peter Claver Catholic School have any programs for students with learning disabilities?

St. Peter Claver Catholic School does not offer any special education services. Students may be offered academic assistance through our Title I tutoring program.
